

Requirements for Admission

The following conditions must be met:

1. You must have completed at least 9 years of fulltime schooling (equivalent to German Hauptschule).
2. You must present a medical certificate showing suitability for the job.
3. You must have adequate German language skills (basic knowledge, equivalent to level A2) (
4. You must provide evidence that you have a provider of practical training.
5. You must have a certificate of a "First Aid-course" (a course for "immediate measures" typical for earning a driver's license is not accepted). This course might be provided by your school or your provider of practical training. If sufficient demand exists, our school might coordinate this training for you.
6. You must have a residence permit.

Vocational school for geriatric care helpers
For citizens with basic knowledge of the German language



Training structure

Training occurs over a 2-year period. It consists of 21 class hours per week in the first year and 15 class hours per week in the second year at the Berufsfachschule (vocational school) Altenpflegehilfe (geriatric care helper) and 1600 hours of practical training in an inpatient or outpatient institution for the care of the elderly.

There is a final exam at the end of the training.

Education goal

Trainees learn to care for the elderly as individuals with specific needs and to support them in their daily life.

Students learn to deal with medical, psychological, legal and social issues, gain nursing skills, and develop a professional identity.

Contents of the practical training

1. Knowledge of the fields of practice
2. Qualified participation and assistance in the treatment, management and care of healthy or infirm elderly people.
3. Assumption of partial tasks in all areas in accord with the training and under guidance.

What are the next possible steps?

The vocational qualification as a care helper enables one to start the training for a geriatric nurse. A grade point average of 2.5 or better on the final care helper's exam may allow you to shorten the training for a geriatric nurse.

Once promoted into the third year of this program with acceptable grades, you may be awarded the certificate of intermediate education.

Final exam

The final exam consists of:

- An oral and a written exam in different learning areas.
- A practical exam in nursing and activation at your provider of practical training.

Exam and access authorization

After successful completion of the training, you may apply for the certificate of Nationally Certified Geriatric Support Assistant ("staatlich anerkannter/r Altenpflegehelfer/in").
